



## *School Uniform*

School Uniform is worn on all school days unless parents are notified of a change. The following is the school uniform for S.N. Chóbh Chionn tSáile:

Our crested school jumper, polo shirt and jacket are available at Laura's School Wear, Dosco Business Park, Douglas – 0214368210. All other items can be purchased at any department store.

All items of uniform should be clearly labelled with the child's name. It would be appreciated if pupils in the infant classes wear shoes with Velcro straps. Please also refer to the Dress Code Policy.

## *Dress Code*

The Board of Management endeavours to maintain the highest of standards in matters of dress code and personal appearance for all pupils in the school.

Accordingly, the Board stipulates that parents must ensure that pupils comply with these standards in matters of general appearance, dress, hairstyles and jewellery at all times during the school term.

The designated school uniform must be worn by pupils during the school day.

- \* Jewellery e.g. neck-chains, long earrings etc., are not allowed for safety reasons. One earring per ear is acceptable (body piercing is not allowed).
- \* Hair must be kept out of eyes and long hair must be tied back.
- \* Hairstyles in unnatural colours are not allowed. Haircuts to be a minimum of blade 2 and no lines to be shaved into the hair.

The Principal, with the permission and full authorisation of the Board, reserves the right to fully implement this code without exception.
